Mayor Corino called the Public Hearing on Local Law 1-2026 and the Village of Shortsville Budget 2026-2027 order at 4:30 P.M.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Local Law No. 1-2026 “A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established by General Municipal Law §3-c.”

Mayor Corino asked for any public comment. There were no public comments.

Mayor Corino asked for any public comment two more times. There were no public comments.

Trustee Langdon made a motion to adopt Resolution 5-2026, seconded by Trustee Schaertl, voted and unanimously carried as follows:

RESOLUTION 5-2026 TO ADOPT LOCAL LAW 1-2026 ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW TO OCERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED BY GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c

At a Public Hearing of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Shortsville, County of Ontario, New York, held at the Village Hall at 6 East Main Street in said Village on the 15th day of April, 2026 at 4:30 PM. The public hearing was called to order by Mayor Ernest Corino and the following were

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held thereon the 15th day of April, 2026, at which time all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard thereon

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Local Law 1-2026 be enacted as follows:
A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED BY GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c

Mayor Corino read the tentative figures in the proposed Village Budget for the 2026-2027 fiscal year:
General Appropriations \$1,202,550
Water Appropriations \$218,290
Sewer Appropriations \$211,090

The Village of Shortsville’s tax rate will be reduced to \$6.97/1,000. The sewer rate, water rate including Operation & Maintenance fees, and overage fees will remain the same. The water rates for inside users are \$30/1,000 cubic feet and the overage is \$6 per each 100 cubic feet. The water rates for outside users are \$60/1,000 cubic feet and the overage is \$12 per each 100 cubic feet. The sewer rates for inside users are \$70/2,000 cubic feet and the overage is \$7 per each 200 cubic feet. The sewer rates for outside users are \$105/2,000 cubic feet and the overage is \$10.50 per each 200 cubic feet. The Operation & Maintenance fee will remain \$20 per quarter. New water service and new sewer service tap in fees will remain \$1,500.

Mayor Corino asked for any public comment.

Kim Parmarter asked if the O&M charge was necessary.

Mayor Corino asked two more times for public comment. There was none.

Trustee Schaertl made a motion to adopt Resolution 6-2026, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and unanimously carried as follows:

RESOLUTION 6-2026 TO ADOPT 2026-2027 VILLAGE BUDGET
