Mayor Corino opened the Village Board Meeting order at 6:00 P.M.

Motion was made by Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Schaertl, voted and carried unanimously to accept the March 2026 Trial Balance and Revenue/Expenditure Analysis.

Board Items:

Mayor Corino introduced newly elected Trustee Matt Schaertl.

Dan Johnstone asked the board for permission to put up a sign at the RC Car Park. Mr. Johnstone previously provided the board with pictures of what the sign will look like. Mr. Johnstone is also working on what rules should be posted down there. Trustee Schaertl asked about the size of the sign. The sign will be 3’X4’ and the plan is to have the rules posed directly below the sign. Mr. Johnston will provide the board with an updated list of rules when it is complete. Trustee Schaertl made a motion to approve the installation of the sign at the RC Car Park, seconded by Trustee Langdon, voted and carried unanimously.

Mayor Corino made a motion to set the date of April 15, 2026 at 4:30 P.M. in the Village Hall for the Public Hearing on the proposed 2026-2027 budget, seconded by Trustee Langdon and carried.

Mayor Corino asked Trustee Schaertl to forward on any information he currently has on it to the board members. Trustee Schaertl would like the village to review the current village insurance requirements. Mayor Corino asked for any information to be forwarded on to the board.

Chief Wagner gave his monthly reports. Chief Wagner also spoke on recent flooding and potentially purchasing some pumps to have available in the future. Chief Wagner will continue to look into this.

There was no further business to come before the board, so the meeting was adjourned by motion of Trustee Langdon, seconded by Trustee Schaertl and carried at 6:48 P.M.
