Update on the culvert project:

Bidding ended at the end of February

The engineers(B&L) have notified the "Apparent Low bidder". That company was City Hall Excavating, Inc.

City Hall is now required to submit some mandatory paperwork to B&L (MBE/WBE/SDVOC Pre-Award Participation Package). B&L will then review the "package" and submit their recommendation package to the Village and NYS DOT to approve.

We are currently waiting for that.

As it looks right now, there are no hold ups and the project will be on schedule.

Time line looks like the culvert will be in October 2026 if City Hill is awarded the project.

Trustee Trimm made a motion second by Mayor Corino to save the date July 25,2026 for the Village Street Dance voted upon and carried unanimously.
